# **1.Product features**

# 2. Product Description

SM220 Copper Small Form Pluggable (SFP) transceivers are based on the SFP Multi Source Agreement (MSA). They are compatible with the Gigabit Ethernet and 10/100/1000BASE-T standards as specified in IEEE Std 802.3.

The SM220 uses the SFP's RX\_LOS pin for link indication. If pull up SFP's TX\_DISABLE pin, IC be reset.

3. Should be pulled up with 4.7k - 10k Ohms on host board to a voltage between 2.0 V and 3.6 V. MOD\_DEF(0) pulls line low to indicate module is plugged in.




Figure 1. Diagram of host board connector block pin numbers and names

# 5. +3.3V Volt Electrical Power Interface

The SM220 has an input voltage range of 3.3 V +/- 5%. The 4V maximum voltage is not allowed for continuous operation.

### 6. Low-Speed Signals

MOD\_DEF(1) (SCL) and MOD\_DEF(2) (SDA), are open drain CMOS signals (see section VII, "Serial Communication Protocol"). Both MOD\_DEF(1) and MOD\_DEF(2) must be pulled up to host\_Vcc
